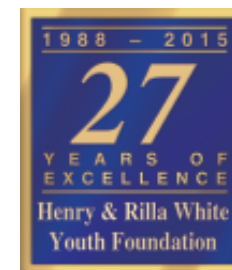

Summary of Bill of Rights

The following is a summary of the membership bill of rights. Each member will receive a document that includes all of the standards that we will meet. The complete member bill of rights is available upon request.

Members

Anyone with a history of mental illness has a lifetime membership and is always welcome to participate in any activities at the clubhouse. Membership determines how to use the clubhouse including the option of writing their own records of participation. Members of the clubhouse will stay in touch with members regardless of the frequency of their participation.

Relationships

All clubhouse meetings are open to staff and membership. Members assume responsibility for the clubhouse and staff is limited.

Space

The clubhouse has its own name and location.

Work Ordered Day

Members participate in two 30 minute groups each day. The remainder of the day is open for socialization and completion of two voluntary self-selected responsibilities to support the clubhouse.

Employment

The clubhouse enables its members to return to paid work through transitional employment, supported employment and independent employment.

Transitional

A desire to work is the highest priority. Employment is part time, usually 15 - 20 hours a week. Clubhouse staff provides training and support during transitional employment.

Supported and Independent

Clubhouse staff assists members to secure, sustain and subsequently, better their employment. Staff maintains a relationship with members.

Education

The staff assists members to reach their vocational and educational goals. Education may be provided outside of the clubhouse but is also provided during the work ordered day.

Functions of the House

The clubhouse objectively evaluates its effectiveness each year. Transportation is arranged for members to ensure transitional work opportunities.

Funding, Governance, and Administration

The clubhouse is fully licensed, insured, and CARF accredited.
