- Youth are earning minimum wage of \$7.67 per hour as of January 2012
- Building stronger partnerships within Circuit Two agencies
- Partners and worksites have supplied lunch, snacks, water/Gatorade, transportation, and supplies (garbage bags, gloves, trash picker uppers)
- Standing item on DJJ Council meeting each month
- 32 youth have successfully come off of the restitution report/Victim Compensation
- Some youth (that don't owe restitution) are working at worksites to earn community service hours or as progressive sanction (alternative to returning to program or back to Court)
